Our volunteers must dress appropriately and respect conservative Fijian values during the project phase. Women must be sensitive in how they dress: Shoulders should be covered, shorts must go to the knee and you cannot wear vest tops or trousers. We also ask volunteers not to wear any revealing clothing in the villages such as low-cut or see through tops.

Walking around the village and day to day attire will be a T-shirt and a sulu.

- T-shirts to be worn, no vests or revealing tops.
- Knee Length shorts
- 3/4 Leggings with shorts over the top that are just above the knee (no short shorts)
