*The Government Policy & Strategy Directing Our Projects*

The 20-Year Development Plan provides the forward-looking vision for “Transforming Fiji” towards an even more progressive, vibrant and inclusive society. It outlines a framework that encompasses strategic policy manoeuvres, new approaches to development and the aspirations of all Fijians.

The Plan consists of two prongs or approaches, which are designated as “Inclusive Socio-economic Development” and ‘Transformational Strategic Thrusts’. These prongs are mutually inclusive and reinforcing.

The NDP is the outcome of a nationwide consultation process and reflects the aspirations of the Fijian people, and their Government’s commitment to deliver on these goals. The NDP is aligned with global commitments including the UN Sustainable Development Goals and the Paris Agreement on Climate Change. .
