

NDC HUB – 2019

A new Regional Pacific Nationally Determined Contributions (NDC) Hub Office has been opened by Fiji's Prime Minister Honourable Voreqe Bainimarama in Suva.

The creation of the Pacific NDC Hub was inspired in the wake of the Paris Agreement, which was widely applauded as a universal call for all nations to band together to combat climate change, based on bottom-up contributions which will be reviewed and strengthened over time in five-year cycles. NDCs are aimed at achieving ambitious but essential long-term goals of limiting global temperature rise and building resilience to climate impacts.

The overall objective of Pacific NDC Hub is:

- for Pacific Island Countries to enhance and implement their NDCs
- driving sustainable and resilient development
- transition to a low carbon development pathway.
- provide technical and facilitate partnerships to enhance and implement the region's NDCs. The NDC Hub builds upon existing networks and mechanisms in the region. It contributes and aligns to national climate change policies and frameworks, including the Framework for Resilient Development in the Pacific and the Regional Technical Support Mechanism.
