- What resources are available to you as you plan and deliver this research?
- How will you ensure that the research is sustainable in the long-term?
 - Could you include further links to be monitored in the future?

Create content ...

- What information does a teacher need to provide effective SIE?
- How will this information improve the provision already provided by the Ministry of Education?
- How will you present your findings?

Barriers to success ...

- What barriers may you face while conducting this research? How could these be overcome?
 - Can you find any examples of how other organisations have overcome similar issues?
- How could you overcome the following types of barriers to the success of your research?:
 - Practical (e.g. ability to access the information you require)
 - Social (e.g. balancing the need to provide more information, without patronising these teachers)
 - Information and Knowledge (e.g. what do you need to know about this sector in order to complete the plan?)

Evaluate ...

- Come back to your original aim has your work achieved the original purpose?
- What method of evaluation will you use/recommend to evaluate the success of the research?
 - When should this evaluation take place?
- How can these results be used to continue to improve the project?
- How will you ensure that the research you have created can be adapted as the organisation grows?
