Waidroka Bay require one proposal for use by staff and community members and there is currently no set budget for the implementation of this project.

- Will additional documents/sections be required for project implementation, maintenance and public information?
- What information will you require in order to make these materials e.g. images, stats?

Barriers to success ...

- What are the potential barriers to the planting of a mangrove shoreline? (e.g. financial, practical, attitudinal)
- What are the potential solutions?
- Is the planting period limited by season?

Evaluate ...

- How will you evaluate the success of the project? What evaluation methods will you use? (e.g. interviews, surveys, focus groups, observational studies)
- How will you present your project? PDF, presentation, video? (combination of all)
- What areas of Think Pacific's Skill Series will you use?
