Enabling Funds

1. Talent Identification (Phase 2)

- Two (2) workshops (Suva and Nadi)
- Duration: 2-3 days
- Outcome: Extensive review of current and prospective Paralympians

2. Engagement with our National Federations (phase 1)

- Dec – Mid January
- Outcome: Execution of MOU/ Lay the platform for a national framework for change/development

3. Costs

- Logistics (Transport for participants, accommodation, venue)
- Professional fees (Facilitator, Legal – MOU review)
- Administrative fees
