## **Further Information:**

The waters directly outside the resort are within a reef. The area has limited depth and current, and, although inhabited by various sea creatures, including sharks, has a rather featureless bottom and lacks natural coral growth.

In an attempt to promote marine life in this location, we would like to create an artificial reef. Our goal is to ensure that fish and other marine animals, looking for a place to live and reproduce, have the best environment available.

There is strong evidence that purpose-built artificial reefs in coastal areas can quickly increase the local fish population, as well as promote coral and algae growth.

Your primary objective would be to develop detailed, well planned, guidelines for the implementation of an artificial reef outside our resort. The development should encourage greater awareness of the importance of artificial reefs and the benefits for the marine environment that they can generate.

- How to include the local community

- How will you ensure your project is sustainable and easy to implement?
